

AUGUST C. ZURCHER RETIRED NKP MAN SUGGUMBS THURSDAY

August C. Zurcher, 78, 222 Green St., retired NKP railroad yard foreman, died in Bellevue Hospital at 7:25 p.m. yesterday following three months' failing health. He had been seriously ill during the past four weeks.

Born Dec. 19, 1870, in Sandusky, he was the son of Clarence and Mary Zurcher. In 1902 he was married in Reed Twp. to Rose M.

Schriner. Mr. Zurcher was a member of the Knights of Columbus and the Eagles lodge.
