Clarence Ball, 85, 407 N. Main St., Attica, died Monday, September 10, 1990 in Mercy Hospital-Willard following a brief illness.

He was born May 30, 1905 in Attica to Aloys and Emma (Schreiner) Ball. On June 5, 1928, he married Dorothy Ball and she survives.
