Mark Quintin Brickner, 83, of Lindsay Avenue, Tiffin, died at 6:20 a.m. Sunday, April 15, 2007, at his residence.

He was born March 22, 1924, in Tiffin, to Joseph L. and Rose Agatha (Scherger) Brickner. On Oct. 22, 1955, in St. Joseph Catholic Church, Tiffin, he married Rose Marie Klopp, and she survives.

The funeral Mass will be 10 a.m. today, April 17, 2007, at St. Mary Catholic Church, with the Rev. David Ross officiating. Entombment will follow in Seneca Memory Gardens Mausoleum, with military rites conducted by the Seneca County United Veterans Council.
