CHARLES H. HUELSMAN, 97, Chickasaw, died at noon Nov. 16, 2001, at Briarwood Manor Nursing Home, Coldwater.  
He was born March 23, 1904, in Cranberry Prairie to the late John and Mary Meiring Huelsman. On July 10, 1929, he married Mary C. Zahn, who died Aug. 5, 2001.  
Mr. Huelsman founded Huelsman Garage in Chickasaw in 1927. He was a member of the Precious Blood Catholic Church, Chickasaw. He was a member of the Knights of St. John, Maria Stein, and the Independent Garage Owners Association. He was co-founder of the Chickasaw Fire Department in 1928, serving as chief from 1928 to 1953, and co-founder of the Chickasaw Water Department in 1947. He was a member of the former Chickasaw school board, serving as clerk.

He was preceded in death by two sons, Charles E. and Frederick Huelsman; a brother, William Huelsman; two sisters, Clara (Vic) Eifert and Alvina Huelsman; and three great-grandchildren.
