

## EDWARD PITTS

Edward Pitts, 83, 319 North Buckeye St., died at 1:35 a.m. today in Bellevue Hospital, where he had been admitted Monday. He had been in failing health for five years.

Mr. Pitts was born Dec. 21, 1890, in Avon Lake, the son of Christopher and Gertrude Theisen Pitts. He was married on Jan. 26, 1921, in Cleveland to the former Rose Rospert, who survives. Also surviving is a daughter, Rosemary Pitts, Youngstown.

He was a former retired employee of the Cleveland Graphite Bronze Co., retiring 17 years ago when the family moved to Bellevue. A veteran of World War I, he was a member of the American Legion and of the Immaculate Conception Church.

Two sisters and a brother preceded him in death.
