## Rites Wednesday for Mrs. Leonard Breidenbach

Mrs. Elinora (Krupp) Breidenbach, 63, wife of Leonard Breidenbach, died at 3 a. m. Sunday, Sept. 5, 1943, in her home on Rural Route 2 in Hopewell township. She had been ill for 10 months.

Mrs. Breidenbach was born in Seneca county May 5, 1890, to John and Margaret (Smith) Krupp, and she was married in St. Joseph's church Feb. 13, 1913 to Leonard Breidenbach. She is survived by her husband, three sons and a daughter: Richard and Mrs. Vincent Babb, both of Tiffin; and Pfc. Bernard, who is stationed on the Alaskan Highway and who arrived here 10 days before his mother's death occurred; and Gerald, at home; the following brothers and sisters, Mrs. Cora Shultz, Albert, and Louis Krupp, all of Toledo; Otto Krupp, Cambridge; Mrs. Lena Shultz, Mansfield; and Charles Krupp, Oberlin; and two grandchildren. Three children are deceased.

Funeral services are to be held at 9 a. m. Wednesday in St. Joseph's church and will be followed by burial in the parish cemetery. The body was removed Sunday afternoon from the Pahl funeral home to the residence where friends may call.
