

ILLNESS OF YEAR CAUSES DEATH OF BISMARK LADY

FUNERAL SERVICES OF MRS.

Funeral services were held at St. Sebastian's Catholic church in Bismark this morning for Mrs. Joseph Elmlinger, Rev. Fr. Brandt officiating at requiem mass. Interment was in the Bismark cemetery.

Mrs. Elmlinger, who was one of the pioneers of the Bismark community and widely known throughout this vicinity, died on Thursday after an illness of a year's duration. She was 77 years of age.

Mr. Elmlinger had preceeded her in death 22 years ago, the surviving members of her family being three sons and three daughters, also two sisters, Mrs. Joseph Briehl, sr., of Bellevue, Mrs. Charles Houff, Lorain, and two brothers, Michael and Joseph Weidinger, of Kenton.
