

MRS. ANNA FRISCH CLAIMED BY DEATH

Long Illness Is Fatal To Mother Of Nine At Reed- town Today.

Mrs. Anna Hahl Frisch, aged 83, passed away at 10:30 o'clock this morning at the home of her daughter, Mrs. J. W. Holmer, at Reedtown, following a lengthy illness. She had been bedfast for two months.

Born July 9, 1857, she was married in 1875 to Jos. Frisch, and had spent most of her life in this vicinity. Her husband preceded her in death.

She was the mother of nine children, of whom six survive, including four daughters, Mrs. Edgar Daniel, of Republic; Mrs. Albert Daniel, of Tiffin; Mrs. Theodore Rospert, this city; Mrs. J. W. Holmer, of Reedtown; and two sons Frank Frisch, of Frank, Wm. Frisch, of Attica. Two sisters, Mrs. Theodore North, of Monroeville, and Mrs. Jos. Bischoff, of Missouri, also survive.
