### FRED G. FRISCH

Funeral services will be held Monday, 1 p.m. in St. Michael's Catholic Church, Marywood, for Fred G. Frisch, 57, Jefferson St., Flat Rock. Mr. Frisch died Friday at 10:15 a.m. in Bellevue Hospital, following two years illness. He had been in the hospital since Mar. 14.
