

## Henrietta J. Frisch

Henrietta Justina Frisch, age 86, formerly of St. Francis Ave. and Schonhardt St. in Tiffin, died Friday night, April 4, 1997 in St. Francis Health Care Center, Green Springs following a lengthy illness.

She was born May 29, 1910 in Huron County to Frederick and Ottilia (Gerber) Missler. Her parents preceded her in death. She married to Leo J. Frisch in Bismark on Feb. 6, 1934 by Father Nicholas Traunero. He died Feb. 10, 1986.
