BUCYRUS - Ronald E. Fritz, rural Bucyrus, died Thursday morning, June 26, 2008 at his residence after a short illness. He was 58.

Born Jan. 11, 1950 in Bucyrus, he was a son of Philip and Loretta (Hahler) Fritz. He married Terry Hart on Sept. 9, 1972 and she survives.

Mr. Fritz also is survived by three brothers, LeRoy and Julius, both of Bucyrus; and Melvin, Cincinnati; a sister, Yvonne Brown, Nevada; and numerous nieces and nephews.

Mr. Fritz was a 1969 graduate of Bucyrus High School. He retired from Timken after 30 years of employment and most recently, worked for the valet service at Bucyrus Community Hospital.
