Matthew Richard Gase, 37, of Miami Street, Tiffin, died at 7:56 a.m., Friday, June 27, 2008, as the result of an automobile accident in Huron County.

He was born, Sept. 1, 1970, in Tiffin, to Richard Otto and Mary Lou (Seislove) Gase. His father died, March 31, 2008, and his mother survives in Tiffin.
