

DEATH AT FRANK

Anthony Hamm, Pioneer Resident and Civil War Veteran, Passed Away Sunday Evening.

Death has claimed another pioneer resident of Frank in the person of Anthony Hamm, who passed away Sunday evening at six o'clock at the advanced age of 82 years and 6 months. The deceased had been in falling health for several months and death was due to hardening of the arteries.

Born in Peru township, Huron county, the deceased, when a child of four, moved with his parents to a farm near Frank where he grew to manhood and spent the balance of his life.

He was married to Margaret Schreiner in 1877 and to this union was born five children: August Hamm and Mrs. Mary Lorenzen, of St. Louis, Michigan, Mrs. Anna Rospert, of Reedtown, who died in 1899; Joseph Hamm and Mrs. John Thiery, of Reedtown.

Mrs. Hamm died in 1877. Five years later Mr. Hamm was united in marriage to Miss Anna Bertsche, the widow who survives.

One child was born to this union, a daughter, now Mrs. Thomas Kuffint, of Cleveland.

Mr. Hamm leaves no brothers or sisters, being the last of his family.

He was a soldier of the Civil war having served through the rebellion as a member of the 49th Regt. O. V. I., and received an honorable discharge.

Mr. Hamm was baptized and confirmed in the Catholic faith and was a member of the Catholic church at Frank where the funeral took place Wednesday morning at nine o'clock, Rev. Faist officiating with interment in the cemetery adjoining.
