Henry Herrick, 63, Monroeville, O., passed away suddenly at his home Monday at 5 p.m. following a heart attack.

Mr. Herrick, a retired Nickel Plate Railroad employe, had lived in the community for 50 years. He was born Jan. 1, 1894 in Seneca Co. near Tiffin, O. He was preceded in death by his wife, Amanda Schriener Herrick Aug. 19, 1944 and a daughter, Jeane, in 1941.
