Adam J. KRUPP, 71, of 1602 Highland av., died at 10:20 a.m. Tuesday [20 Jan 1970] in Mercy Medical Center following three months of serious illness.

He was born Dec. 24, 1898, in Springfield, the son of Adam J. and Mary JUNG KRUPP and had resided here all of his life.

He was employed as a machinist for the White Diesel Engine Division for 25 years, retiring in 1960.
