

FUNERAL FRIDAY FOR CLARA KRUPP

Died This Morning in St. Clair Street Home

Mrs. Clara B. (Bollinger) Krupp, 77, of 46 St. Clair street, died in her home at 1:25 a.m. today, Jan. 9, 1957, after having been ill for 18 months and in serious condition for three months.

A native of Bettsville, Mrs. Krupp was born Nov. 2, 1879, to A. Bollinger and Barbara (Bergstresser) Bollinger and was married in Tiffin, July 17, 1901, to Charles J. Krupp, who died Feb. 18, 1953.

She had resided in Tiffin for the last 15 years, coming here from Norwalk after a residence there of 35 years. Her early life was also spent in the Tiffin community.

Surviving are a daughter, Mrs. Joseph Schostek, of Tiffin, one grandson and one great-granddaughter.

Mrs. Krupp was a member of St. Mary church, where funeral services will be held at 9 a.m. Friday. Burial will be in St. Joseph cemetery.
