PALM DESERT, CA - David W. Krupp, 78, was born in Fremont, Ohio on February 2, 1931, the son of Walter and Mary Krupp. He spent most of his early life in Port Clinton, Ohio, where he graduated from high school as a member of the National Honor Society. He earned 12 varsity letters in football, basketball and track and was named to the second All-Ohio teams in two of these sports.

He attended the University of Michigan on a basketball [scholarship](#) and was a member of that school's varsity basketball team for three years. He was a member of Phi Delta Theta fraternity.

Following graduation, he became publicity manager at Greenfield Village, Dearborn, Michigan and later spent 35 years in public relations with Ford Motor Company including nine years as regional manager of its west coast public relations office where he maintained a residence in Newport Beach, California. After retiring from Ford, he was a consultant for J. Walter Thompson. In his later years he maintained residences in Bloomfield Hills, Michigan, and Rancho Mirage, California, where he was a member of The Springs Country Club.
