Douglas A. Krupp, a computer programmer, died of cancer yesterday in the Hospice of Northwest Ohio, Perrysburg Township. He was 35.

Mr. Krupp was born in Fostoria but grew up here, according to his sister, Annette Serviss.

He earned an associate's degree in computer science from Owens Community College, Perrysburg Township, and was a programmer for St. Vincent Mercy Medical Center, Toledo, until eight years ago, when he took a job with SCC Resources, Inc., Sandusky, as a programmer/analyst.

Mr. Krupp worked until November, when his illness forced him to quit, his sister said.

Mr. Krupp was an enthusiastic golfer and enjoyed fishing.

He was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church, Millersville. He played guitar in church groups.

"He was a very good Christian," Ms. Serviss said.

Surviving are his parents, David and Kathleen; sons, Jeremy, Brian, and Aaron; sister, Annette Serviss; brothers, David, Robert, and Daniel, and grandmothers, Marie Steinmetz and Agnes Krupp.

The body will be in the Nopper-Veh Funeral Home, Gibsonburg, after 7 p.m. today, with a wake service at 8:45 p.m. tomorrow. Services will be at 10:30 a.m. Monday in the church.
