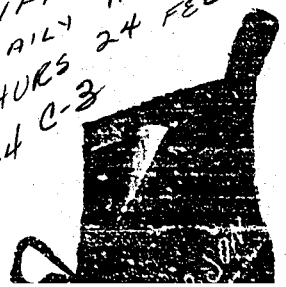

OBITUARY.

KRUPP.

Mrs. Jacobina Krupp, widow of the late Daniel Krupp and one of Tiffin's oldest residents, died at her home, 62 Liberty street, at 5:30 a. m. to-day, aged eighty years. The funeral takes place from St. Joseph's Catholic church at 8:30 o'clock Saturday morning.

Mrs. Krupp was born in Germany in February, 1818, and came to America with her husband, Peter Bern, in 1848, moving into the house in which she died. Here her husband died in 1861, and a year later she was married to Adam Koch, who died in 1883. In April, 1887, she was married to Daniel Krupp and was again left a widow a third time in November of the same year. She had no children of her own, but was the step-mother of Anthony Krupp, of this city, and of Mrs. Agnes Bockey, nee Koch, of Delphos, who, with her daughter, Miss Anna Bockey, have been in the city caring for Mrs. Krupp for the past six weeks.
