

MYRTA KRUPP, 87, DIED WEDNESDAY

Funeral Services to be Held Saturday

Mrs. Myrta A. Krupp, 87, widow of John Krupp, died at 11:45 p.m. Wednesday, April 5, 1960, in the home of her son Earl, on rural route 5 in Hopewell township. She had been in poor health for five years and her condition was serious for the last five months.

Born in Republic May 14, 1872, Mrs. Krupp was the last surviving of the children of Mr. and Mrs. Levi Taylor. She resided in the general vicinity of Tiffin most of her life. Surviving are four sons, Cecil, Oscar, and Joseph, all of Mansfield; Earl, with whom she resided; three daughters, Mrs. Mabel Lupton, Ft. Worth, Texas; Mrs. Vesta Whiteman, Tiffin; and Mrs. Alice Marsteller, Stony Ridge; 11 grandchildren, and 15 great-grandchildren. Her husband, John Krupp, and three sons preceded her in death.

Mrs. Krupp was a member of the First English Lutheran church.

Funeral services will be held in the Hoffmann Memorial at 1:30 p.m. Saturday and will be conducted by the Rev. William A. Janson and the Rev. W. O. Kantner. Interment will be in Greenlawn cemetery.
