

NEIL KRUPP, 35, DIES IN MANSFIELD HOME

Funeral Services To Be Held Saturday

Neil Krupp, 35, who formerly resided on the Coe road near Tiffin, died at 4:20 a. m. today, Sept. 10, 1942, in Mansfield where he resided with his mother, Mrs. Myrta Krupp. He had been an invalid for the past 12 years.

Mr. Krupp had been with his mother at Mansfield for the past two years. His father, John Krupp, is deceased. Surviving, in addition to his mother, are the following brothers and sisters, Mrs. Lester Whiteman, Mrs. Herbert Lupton, and Earl Krupp, all of Tiffin; Mrs. John Marsteller, Stony Ridge; and Joseph, Cecil, and Oscar, all of Mansfield. Another brother, Paul, was fatally injured in an accident near here about eight years ago.

Funeral services are to be held at 2 p. m. Saturday in the Jones Memorial at Mansfield and will be conducted by the Rev. Dr. Grover E. Swoyer, pastor of the Lutheran church at Mansfield. Burial will be in Memorial Park cemetery, Mansfield.
