Also surviving are two sons, David P. of Fostoria, Nathan of Salem, Ore.; a daughter, Janet Therriault, Palm Bay, Fla.; five grandchildren; and seven great-grandchildren.

Mr. Krupp retired as a writer for the Review-Times newspaper, Fostoria, in 1991. He had worked for the company since 1923, first in the sales and delivery departments, then as a printer and advertising representative.

He was a member of First Church of the Nazarene, Fostoria; former member of the Fostoria YMCA, where he was active at both local and state levels; founder of and former member and first president of Fostoria Lions Club; 32nd degree Mason and member of Masonic Lodge 288, F&AM, Fostoria.

He graduated from Fostoria High School in 1923.
