PORT HURON - Roland G. "Bud" Krupp, 91, of Port Huron, died Sunday, July 30, 2006 after a long illness.

He was born July 4, 1915 in Sebewaing, to the late Joseph and Elizabeth Krupp.

He married Dorothy Neighorn on July 15, 1944 in Port Huron. She died September 25, 2001.

Mr. Krupp began his career in 1935 as an inspector at Mueller Brass Company. He rose through various positions in the technical and inspection departments and became Executive Vice President in 1970 and Chairman of the Board in 1972. He continued consulting and taught at Port Huron School of Business after retiring in 1980. He was a member of American Institute of Metallurgical Engineers, the Wire Association, American Society for Metals and Port Huron Torch Club.

He received a bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering from Lawrence Institute of Technology in 1945 and received an MBA from Wayne State University in 1970. Lawrence Institute honored Mr. Krupp with an Alumni Achievement Award in 1966. He was an elder of First Presbyterian Church. Mr. Krupp was very active in civic affairs. He was board member, past president and campaign chairman of the United Way of St. Clair County, past president of Port Huron Kiwanis Club, board member of the Blue Water Council Boy Scouts of America, member of the Mercy Hospital Board for 17 years, served on the Family Service Agency of St. Clair County and was a board member of the St. Clair County Community Foundation.

He is survived by three daughters, Mr. and Mrs. Tim (Charlene) Catalina of Port St. Lucie, Florida, Mr. and Mrs. David (Marilyn) Dunn of Port Huron and Mr. and Mrs. Mike (Janet) Kelley of Lynchburg, Virginia; a son, Mr. and Mrs. Robert (Pam) Krupp of Kentfield, California; nine grandchildren; 11 great-grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by a grandson, Jonathan Kelley.

Visitation will be 3 to 5 and 7 to 9 p.m. today in Pollock-Randall Funeral Home.

Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Wednesday in First Presbyterian Church, 811 Wall Street, Port Huron. The Reverend Robert Perdue will officiate.

Burial will be in Lakeside Cemetery, Port Huron.
