

Heart Attack Fatal To William A. Krupp

Tiffin Native Was Publisher
of Pt. Clinton Herald

PORT CLINTON, Ohio (UPI) — Services will be Saturday for William A. Krupp, 79, publisher emeritus of the Port Clinton Herald, who died Wednesday night in McGruder Hospital a few hours after suffering a heart attack at his home.

Krupp, widely known for his activity in the Knights of Columbus, retired from active newspaper work in November, 1947. He and a son, Walter A. Krupp, took over publication of the newspaper in July, 1927.

A native of Tiffin, Krupp married the former Elsie Deer in 1905. He is survived by his wife, three daughters, Mrs. Donald Hoffman and Mrs. Donald Bohling of Port Clinton and Mrs. Paul Van Ness of Bellefontaine; three sons, Walter, Kenneth and Richard, all of Port Clinton; a niece, Mrs. Joseph Fisher of Fremont, 18 grand children and one great-grandchild.

Mr. Krupp also leaves a brother, Ralph, of Tuscon, Ariz. Mr. Helen Krupp of this city is a sister-in-law.
