

MARY AGNES ROSS CLAIMED BY DEATH

Funeral Services to be Held Friday

Mrs. Mary Agnes Ross, 72, widow of Claise Ross, died at 11 p. m., Monday, Feb. 14, 1944, in her home at 445 Jefferson street. She had been in failing health for a long time. However, the immediate cause of her death was a stroke of paralysis which she suffered Monday noon.

Mrs. Ross was born at Frank, Mar. 6, 1871, and was a daughter of Nicholas and Anna (Westerman) Krupp. She had resided in Tiffin for 55 years and was married here Nov. 6, 1894 to Claise Ross who died Mar. 18, 1942. Surviving are the following sons and daughters, Ralph, Mrs. Herman Reinhart, and Mrs. Albert Rex, all of Tiffin; Paul and Roland Wolf, both of Cuyahoga Falls; Harold, at home; two brothers, Louis Krupp, Tiffin; and Joseph Krupp, Lorain; and eight grandchildren and one great-grandchild.

Mrs. Ross was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic church and the Poor Souls society.

Funeral services are to be held at 9 a. m. Friday in St. Joseph's church and will be followed by burial in the parish cemetery. The body will be taken to the residence Wednesday morning from the Hoffmann Memorial.
