Mother of Party Head Dies at 70.

**Mrs. Patrick J. (Margaret E.) MCDONOUGH**, 70, of Pitchin rd., South Charleston, Route 1, mother of John MCDONOUGH, of Springfield, Clark County Democratic Party chairman, died at 11:28 p.m. Sunday [10 Oct 1964] in City Hospital, following an extended illness.

She was born in Springfield, April 21, 1895, the daughter of Adam and Mary JUNG KRUPP. She had resided in Springfield all of her life. She was a member of St. Raphael Church, and the Altar-Rosary Sodality.

In addition to her husband and son, John survivors include two daughters, Miss Margaret MCDONOUGH of Springfield; Mrs. Mary Ellen CULP of Tachikawa, Air Force Base, Japan; seven other sons, Stephen, Paul and Robert, all of Springfield; James of Catawba; Charles of Lawrenceville; Thomas and Michael of South Charleston; four sisters, Mrs. Catherine LEMMONS, Mrs. Louise BLAZER, and Miss Josephine KRUPP, all of Springfield; two brothers, Adam and Clarence of Springfield; 25 grandchildren; and a number of nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by a son Raymond in 1942.
