

## **Donald E. Myers**

Donald E. MYERS, 91, 525 S. Michigan St., Plymouth, died at 3:15 a.m. Wednesday at Pilgrim Manor Nursing Home.

Born in Culver to William J. and Daisy OYLER MYERS, he married Sylvia Irene POLLEY on Sept. 17, 1931 in Culver.

He moved from Rochester in 1938. He attended Rutland School and additional studies in the field of electronics. He first worked at Black and Bailey Hardware, Rochester, then Montgomery Ward, Plymouth, and John Meck Industries and Bendix Corp., South Bend, where he invented and improved production parts. He most recently worked at Hammel Motors.

He operated Myers Appliance Sales and Service, Plymouth, and enjoyed electronics and vintage radios. He was a member of the Indiana Historical Radio Society and Marshall and Fulton counties historical societies. He attended Rochester First Church of God and Plymouth Wesleyan Church.
