## BELLEVUE CHILD DIES FROM EATING FIRECRACKER AT GRANDMOTHER'S HOME

### Tragedy Attends Vacation of Mr. and Mrs. L. L. Palmer When Infant Daughter Dies in Norwalk

A Bellevue family's vacation came to a tragic ending today when Marjorie Anne, sixteen-months-old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. L. L. Palmer, North Railroad street, died at the home of her grandmother, Mrs. Anne Mentz, on North Hester street, Norwalk, from poisoning which resulted from eating a piece of fireworks known as a "son-of-a-gun."

Mr. and Mrs. Palmer and Majorie Anne, their only child, went to Norwalk on Saturday evening to make a vacation visit with the grandmother, tragedy ending their vacation and shrouding their home in grief this morning when Majorie Anne secured and ate the firecracker.

The body will be brought here for funeral services but arrangements had not been completed this afternoon.
