Richard Slingwine, 77 years, of Clyde, Ohio, went to be with the Lord on Sunday, Aug. 8, 2010, at his home in Clyde.

He was born June 4, 1933, in West Lodi, Ohio, the son of Albert and Vivian (Dendinger) Slingwine. He married Kathryn "Katie" (Moyer) Slingwine on April 12, 1958, at Immaculate Conception Catholic Church in Bellevue, by the late Rev. Albert Bishop.
