

MRS. C. C. ROSPERT DIES AT HOSPITAL; SERVICES SATURDAY

Mrs. Theresa Pauline Rospert, 79, widow of Cornelius C. Rospert, 221 Broad St., passed away at Bellevue Hospital Wednesday at 8:40 p.m. She had been in failing health for the past two months and seriously ill three and one half weeks.
