

**Obituary of Mrs. Celestine Scherley                      Sandusky Register   July 9, 1964**

Mrs. Celestine Hahl Scherley, 74, a resident of 516 Shelby St., died unexpectedly Tuesday afternoon in an auto of a daughter parked on Camp Street near the Miller drug store.

A police cruiser was passing at the time and was hailed by the daughter. An ambulance was summoned and the family physician pronounced Mrs. Scherley dead at the scene. It was reported that Mrs. Scherley had been at the physician's office a short time before her death and was waiting in the car while a medical prescription was being filled at the drug store.

Mrs. Scherley was a member of St. Mary's Church and the Altar and Rosary Society of Reed Assumption Church. She lived in Bellevue and Reed before moving to Sandusky a number of years ago.

Surviving are eight daughters, Sister Mary Charles, OSF, Tiffin; Mrs. Helen Russett, Mrs. Walter Meggitt, Mrs. Harold Rhode and Mrs. Harry Williams all Sandusky; Mrs. Leroy Laub, Bellevue; Mrs. Kenneth Evans, White's Landing and Mrs. Eugene Hahler, Willard; two sons, Leonard Scherley, Republic and Arthur, rural Bellevue; 29 grandchildren; two sisters, Mrs. Frank Seasley, Republic and Mrs. Lawrence Bogner, Tiffin and several nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her husband, Charles B., on Dec. 11, 1955 and a son, Edwin, in 1954.
