HERMAN SCHREINER

Herman John Schreiner, 78, West Millgrove, died at 12:35 a.m. Thursday, Aug. 14, 2008, at his residence.

He was born June 14, 1930, in Carey, to Herman R. and Martha M. (Neiderkohl) Schreiner. He married Jean Marie Sherman on April 11, 1953, at St. Joseph's Catholic Church, Tiffin, and she survives. Also surviving are four daughters, Ann Marie Schreiner, Jane Frances Schreiner and Mrs. Mark (Christina D.) Schreiner-Staniszewski, West Millgrove, and Mrs. Craig (Marty Cecelia) Luetkemeyer, Hillsboro, Mo.; two sons, Steven John Schreiner, Tiffin, and Daniel Joseph Schreiner, Portsmouth, Va.; 10 grandchildren; a brother, Melvin Schreiner, Fostoria; and two sisters, Mrs. Jim (Marie) Smith, Findlay, and Mrs. Leo (Catherine) Reinhart Jr., Fostoria.

Preceding him in death were two infant brothers, Wayne J. Schreiner and David H. Schreiner; two brothers, Eugene Schreiner and Howard Schreiner; and his step-father Paul Krupp.

Mr. Schreiner served in Germany in the U.S. Army during the Korean War. He was carpenter who worked for Schreiner Construction and Chrysler Foundry, both of Fostoria. He served as a West Millgrove councilman since 1967 and was a West Millgrove volunteer fireman for 50 years, also serving as an assistant chief. He received a certificate of appreciation from the Wood County Sheriff's Office and a plaque from the fire department.

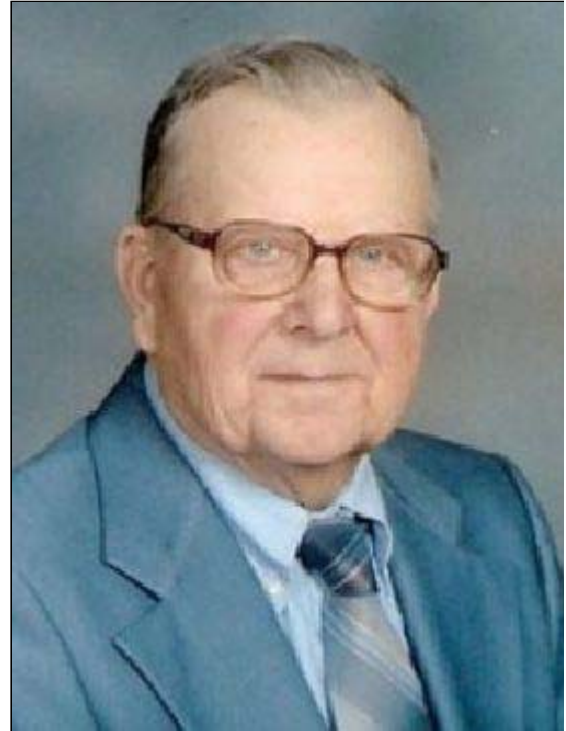
He was a member of St. Wendelin Catholic Church, Fostoria, where he cut all the rosary cords for the rosary makers at the church.
