Philip John Schriener

Philip **John** "Fritz," "Fritzie," **Schriener**, 92, of Kankakee, Ill., died on Thursday, Oct. 7, 2004, in Kankakee.

He graduated from Perdue University with a degree in civil engineering and was the superintendent of public works for the city of Kankakee from 1941 to 1985. He was a longstanding member of the city council and was appointed to the Illinois Governor's Advisory Council in 1969. He was a 60-year member of American Society of Professional Engineers and was an Elk, a Moose, 4th degree Knights of Columbus, and a founding member of Rock Creek Club. He was a lifelong member of St. Patrick's Church. He founded L & S Bait Co. with his brother-in-law, Harold LeMaske.

He was preceded in death by his first wife, Doreen Locke **Schriener** and three brothers, Lewis, Paul and Bernard.

He is survived by his wife, Jean Lawrence **Schriener**; three daughters, Sandra Rooney of Stillwater, Okla., Nancy Wulff of Kankakee, and Jill Dufour of San Antonio, Texas; a sister, Mildred Gagnon of Daytona Beach, and a sister-in-law, Pat **Schriener** of Kankakee.
