

## **SHINDORF, Leopold**

Leopold Shindorf, 63, a resident of Belding and the vicinity all his life, died Friday at the home of a daughter, Mrs. Laverne Taft, near Howard City.

Born in Otisco township March 26, 1876, Shindorf lived on a farm near Belding until recently.

The body was brought to Belding and will repose in the Sales funeral home until Monday morning when it will be taken to St. Mary's Catholic church in Miriam, where funeral services will be held at 9:30 o'clock, with Fr. R. J. Kelley of Belding officiating. Burial will be in Miriam cemetery.
