

M.J. 'Butch' Stockmaster

Marvin J. "Butch" Stockmaster, 52, of 3952 N. Seneca CR 29, Bellevue, died Saturday, July 19, 2003, following a lengthy illness.

He was born Dec. 10, 1950, in Bellevue, to Herbert and Elizabeth (Daniel) Stockmaster. His wife, Marjorie (Schriner) Stockmaster, whom he married Sept. 30, 1972, in St. Michael's Catholic Church, survives.

Other survivors include: a son, Daniel Stockmaster, at home; his father-in-law, James "Jay" Schriner of Bellevue; two brothers, Eugene (Carol) Stockmaster and Gerald (Peggy) Stockmaster, all of Bellevue; and a sister, Roseann (Harold) Reinhart of Tiffin.

He enjoyed playing cards, attending antique steam shows and was a very active worker at barbecues, at festivals and church dinners.
