Sylvester C. Stockmaster, 79, of New Washington, died Tuesday, Sept. 8, 1987, in Heartland Nursing Home, Bucyrus.

He was born Sept. 25, 1907 in Huron County. On Nov. 9, 1940, he married Mary Frisch and she survives.
