

ANEMIA IS FATAL TO REEDTOWNSHIP WOMAN

Mrs. Ida C. Stockmeister, 40, wife of John Stockmeister and mother of six children, died Wednesday night at 9:40 o'clock at the family home along the Sandusky-Columbus road in Reed township. Death was due to anemia and followed an illness of three weeks.

Mrs. Stockmeister was a daughter of Martin and Anna Krupp Schreiner and she was born Aug. 11, 1890 in Venice township. She was married to Mr. Stockmeister at Bismark June 4, 1919, and had spent practically all of her life in Berenca county.

Besides her husband and her parents living in Bismark, Mrs. Stockmeister is survived by six children: Mary, Agnes, Leonard, Arthur, Viola and Irene who is nine months old.
