

PNEUMONIA IS FATAL TO CLARENCE THIERY

Clarence T. Thiery, 23, part owner of the Stein and Thiery recreation center and confectionary at Market and Sandusky streets, died Tuesday night at 10:40 o'clock in Mercy hospital, following a week's illness, due to double pneumonia.

His condition had been critical since Sunday night when he was taken from his home at 266 South Sandusky street to the hospital.

Mr. Thiery was born in Tiffin Feb. 28, 1908, and was the son of Peter and Elizabeth (Dell) Thiery. On completing his education, Mr. Thiery went into business with H. L. Stein. From the start the business was a success and Mr. Thiery made scores of friends.

Besides his parents he is survived by a brother and three sisters: Eugene Thiery of Chicago; Miss Luella Thiery of Detroit, and Miss Mildred Thiery and Miss Helen Thiery of Tiffin.

He was a member of Tiffin council of the Knights of Columbus and St. Joseph's church.

The body was taken from Mercy hospital to the J. William Hoffmann mortuary to be prepared for burial. It will be taken to the residence this evening.

Funeral services will be held Friday morning at nine o'clock in St. Joseph's church. Burial will be in the parish cemetery.
