Native of Tiffin is Dead in
Fostoria

Funeral services for Jacob Henry Thiry, 73, of Fostoria, who died in Fostoria City hospital at 10 a.m., Wednesday, Jan. 20, 1954, will be held in St. Wendelin Catholic church there at 9:30 a.m., Friday. Burial will be in the parish cemetery.
