MRS. ROSE M. THIRY PARALYSIS VICTIM

Funeral to be Held In Attica Saturday

Mrs. Rose M. Thiry, 68, wife of John Thiry, of Siam, died at 3:45 p. m. Wednesday, June 16, 1943, in Mercy hospital where she had been admitted the day before in a critical condition following a stroke of paralysis.

Mrs. Thiry was born in Seneca county Sept. 20, 1874 and was a daughter of Anthony and Margaret (Schriner) Hamm. She was married April 10, 1894 to John Thiry, at Frank, and is survived by her husband and two brothers, August Hamm, St. Louis, Mich.; and Joseph Hamm, Reed township.

Funeral services are to be held at 9:30 a. m. Saturday in St. Peter's and Paul's Catholic church, Attica, following a brief service in the home at 9 a. m. The services will be conducted by the Rev. R. H. Monnin. Burial will be in the parish cemetery. The body will be taken from the Foss funeral home in Attica to the residence where friends may call after tonight.
