**CPL. E. J. WIDMER  
KILLED IN ACTION  
IN FRANCE, JULY 31**

Cpl. Eugene J. Widmer, 35, was killed in action in France on July 31, his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Raymond Widmer, of Frank, were notified yesterday by the War department.

They were notified two weeks ago that he was missing in action since July 31.

Cpl. Widmer was born on Dec. 26, 1908, in Frank and attended the schools there. He entered the Army on June 10, 1941 and had been overseas since Oct. 1, 1943. He had his last furlough home in July 1943. An infantryman, he was assigned to a headquarters company of the 23rd infantry.

Survivors are his parents, three brothers, Florian, Hornell, N.Y., Victor, Lorain, Ralph, of this city; two sisters, Mrs. Herman Heuring, of Toledo, and Luella, at home.
