# ALBERT G. KRUPP DIES IN HOSPITAL

## Was Loomis Machine Em- ploye Many Years

Albert George Krupp, 64, of 83 Clay street, died at 7:15 a. m. today in Mercy hospital in Toledo where he had been a patient since June 8. Previous to that time he had been a patient in Mercy hospital here for about two weeks.

Mr. Krupp was born in Tiffin, Sept. 26, 1884 to Anthony and Rose (Fisher) Krupp. He was married May 25, 1910 to Helen Folkhard, and is survived by his wife, a son and daughter, Mrs. O. M.
