

ALBERT KRÜPP, 69, DIES IN FOSTORIA

Funeral Services to be Held Wednesday

Albert J. Krupp, 69, of 606 West Fremont street, Fostoria, died at 8 a. m. Sunday, Oct. 26, 1952, in his residence of a heart condition after an illness of three months.
