

DEATH TAKES ALBERT KRUPP

Veteran Hardware Dealer Resident of City Half Century.

Albert W. Krupp, 68, veteran Toledo hardware dealer, who suffered a stroke two weeks ago, died early today in the home of his daughter, Mrs. C. J. Kraus, 1730 West Bancroft Street.

A resident of Toledo for half a century, Mr. Krupp was head of the Krupp Hardware Co., 1213 Cherry Street, for the last 39 years. He founded the business as the Mertes & Krupp Co., 40 years ago, but his partner died a year later, and since then he had operated it alone. Prior to establishing his own firm, Mr. Krupp was employed for 10 years by the Stollberg Hardware Co.

A native of Bellevue, O., Mr. Krupp was the son of the late Anthony and Helen Krupp. His wife, Josephine Jacoby Krupp, died three years ago. Besides his daughter, Mr. Krupp is survived by a grandson, Paul M. Kraus, and brothers, Edward C. and John J. Krupp, both of Bellevue.

Services will be held in the Harvey L. Gardner Funeral Home Friday at 8:30 a. m. and requiem high mass will be held in Gesu Church at 9 a. m. Burial will be in the family lot in Mt. Carmel Cemetery. The Holy Name Sodality of Gesu Church, of which Mr. Krupp was a member, will meet to say the rosary in the funeral home tomorrow at 8 p. m. Mr. Krupp also was a member of the Young Men's Catholic Benevolent Association.
