Alvin S. Krupp, 88, formerly of 136 Third Ave., died at 8:20 p.m. Monday, Dec. 17, 1990, in Alta Mira Nursing Home, where he had resided for three years.

He was born Dec. 30, 1901, in Republic, to Lewis and Belle (Taylor) Krupp. In July, 1946, in Reno, Ky., he married Nading Sussang. She died Aug. 17, 1966.
