

# Death Takes Widow of Louis Krupp

## Funeral Services to be Held Saturday.

Mrs. Belle (Taylor) Krupp, 85, widow of Louis Krupp, of 171 Fourth avenue, died at 10:15 a. m., today, Jan. 20, 1954, in the home of her daughter, Mrs. Charles Birch, 385 North Sandusky street, after having been bedfast with a heart ailment for 12 weeks.

Mrs. Krupp had stayed with her daughter for the duration of her last illness.

She was born near Republic, Oct. 19, 1868, to Levi and Mary (Minnich) Taylor, and was married in Tiffin in 1890. Mr. Krupp died Feb. 25, 1947.

Mrs. Krupp lived her entire life in the Republic vicinity and in Tiffin.

Survivors include four sons, Alvin and Orlin of Tiffin, Jesse of Fairmont, W. Va., and Deforest of Toledo; one daughter, Mrs. Charles Birch; one sister, Mrs. Myrta Krupp of Mansfield; one brother, Charles Taylor of Tiffin; 20 grandchildren and 22 great grandchildren.

One son, Floyd, died in 1929. Two other children died in infancy.

Funeral services will be held in the Bame funeral home at 2 p. m., Saturday, with the Rev. H. Joe Grimm, pastor of the Ebenezer E. U. B. church, officiating. Burial will be in Fairmont cemetery.
