

DEATH OF MRS. JOHN KRUPP

Respected Pioneer Resident Passes
Away at Advanced Age.

Tuesday afternoon at 2:15 o'clock death claimed a pioneer and respected resident of this city, Mrs. John Krupp at her home on Jackson street. Mrs. Krupp has been in failing health for some time and a few days ago fell and fractured her hip. Since then there had been little hope for her recovery. She was 79 years of age on October 15, last.

There survive of the family the aged father and husband, John Krupp and three children, Mr. Chas. J. Krupp, Mr. Jacob Krupp and Mrs. Paul Miller. Another daughter, Mrs. Herbert Herb, passed away at her home in Perkins Monday afternoon.
