Charles A. Krupp Dies At 80

Death claimed Charles A. Krupp, 80, of 4021 Canterbury Ct., Tuesday in Shield's Nursing Clinic, 3905 Oberlin Ave., after a long illness.

Born in Franks, O., he was a resident here since 1907.

He was a graduate of Ohio Northern Pharmacy School and was a pioneer pharmacist in Lorain operating his own drug store on Grove Ave. for over 30 years.

Mr. Krupp was a former member of St. Mary Church, and recently a member of St. Peter Church, Knights of Columbus, Eagles Lodge 343, Elks Lodge 1301 and Ohio State Pharmaceutical Association.
