

CHARLES KRUPP RITES SATURDAY

Merchant Dies After Brief Illness

Funeral services for Charles J. Krupp, 74, who died at 11:45 a. m. Wednesday, Feb. 18, 1953, in his home at 46 St. Clair Street, are to be held at 9 a. m. Saturday in St. Mary's Catholic Church. Burial will be made in St. Joseph's cemetery. Friends may call at the Hoffmann Memorial after 7 p. m. this evening.

Mr. Krupp had been ill since he suffered a heart attack Monday in his store at 122 Miami street. He formerly operated a drug store in Norwalk for 40 years, and had been proprietor of the store here about 16 years. He was born in Tiffin, Oct. 8, 1878, to Anthony and Rose (Fisher) Krupp, and was married here July 17, 1901 to Clara Bollinger.

Surviving in addition to his widow, are a daughter, Mrs. Madeline Schostek, Tiffin; a grandson, James Schostek; a sister and two brothers, Mrs. Olivia Beechner, Tiffin; William Krupp, Port Clinton; and Ralph Krupp, Tucson, Ariz.; and a half sister, Mrs. Clara Smith, Gladwin, Mich. Mr. Krupp was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church and of the Knights of Columbus.
