# Service Saturday For Dr. Krupp

Solemn Requiem Mass will be conducted Saturday at 12:15 p.m. at St. Peter Church for Dr. Gerald J. Krupp, 61, prominent Lorain physician who died yesterday following a heart attack.

Rev. Albert A. Krupp, one of four sons of Dr. Krupp and assistant pastor of St. Angela Merici Church, Fairview Park, will be celebrant, assisted by two other priests.

The Mass will follow funeral services at 11:45 a.m. Saturday at Reidy - Scanlan Funeral Home where friends may call from 7 p.m. until 10 p.m. today and from 10 a.m. until 10 p.m. tomorrow.

**BURIAL WILL** be in Calvary Cemetery.

A memorial service will be conducted by the Lorain Lions Club at 7 p.m. tomorrow at the funeral home. It will be followed by the recitation of the Rosary by Knights of Columbus, Lorain County 637, 8 p.m.

Dr. Krupp had interned at St. Mary Hospital, Clayborn, Mo., following graduation in 1931 from St. Louis University School of Medicine with a doctor of medicine degree.

He opened an office in 1932 on Pearl Avenue in South Lorain, later moved to E. 28th Street and Broadway and for the past 29 years had an office for the general practice of medicine at 2703 Broadway.

He was a member of St. Peter Church, former member of St. Mary Church, and was a member of Holy Name Society of St. Peter Church, Knights of Columbus, Lorain Elks Lodge 1301 and Lorain Lions Club.

He also was affiliated with the Lorain County and Ohio State medical societies, American Academy of General Practice and American Medical Association.

Survivors include his widow, the former Blanche Derrid, four sons, Dr. Neal E. Krupp, associated with Mayo Clinic Rochester, Minn.; Dr. Ralph J. Krupp, Lorain dentist; Myron J. Krupp of Atlanta, Ga., and Father Krupp; three daughters, Mrs. Stephen J. (Mary Patricia) ... of ... Village.
